Subject **Notification of Document Adoptions and APIM Approvals,
at the 2009 AEEC Mid Term
October 28, 2009 in Orlando, Florida**

Summary AEEC adopted 9 revisions to existing ARINC Standards (listed in Attachment 1) at the 2009 AEEC Mid Term. Last minute "Pink Page" revisions were submitted for ARINC Specification 633 containing some editorial corrections that will be included in the Supplement. These new Supplements to ARINC Standards will be published pending no adverse comments within 30 days.

AEEC approved 5 ARINC Project Initiation/Modifications (APIM) (listed in Attachment 2) at the 2009 AEEC Mid Term. Four of these fall within existing subcommittee charters. These new tasks will be launched according to their projected schedules without forming any new subcommittees. The EFB Users Forum will be formed as a new activity. ExCom direction is that the first meeting should be conducted in the spring of 2010.

Inputs Invited This notification initiates a 30-day period for the submission of any objections to the publication of the adopted documents or activity to begin work on the approved APIMs.

Action Please notify Mike Russo in writing by **December 18, 2009**, if you know of any reason the adopted documents should not be published or work should not begin on any of the approved APIMs.
