## AGIE/MAGIC Subcommittee Meeting Objectives

The AGIE/MAGIC Subcommittee, chaired by Manfred Benten and Jerry Price, will meet September 27-29, 2010, to review inputs to ARINC Project Papers 830 and 839.

**ARINC Project Paper 839** is expected to define an interface boundary for on-board software applications and IP-based air-ground data links. This may include Gatelink, Terrestrial Broadband, and Satellite broadband communication services. Internet protocols and existing IETF standards are expected to be the basis for the development of this standard. The standard is expected to support the Airline Information Services (AIS) domain and the Passenger Information and Entertainment Services (PIES) domain initially.

**ARINC Project Paper 830** Aircraft/Ground Information Exchange (AGIE) is expected to specify protocols for application-to-application information exchange between the aircraft and the airline ground infrastructure. The specification is expected to allow ground applications to “store and forward” data for individual aircraft applications such as EFB, document viewers, electronic logbooks and other types of data transfer. Simple Object Access Protocol (SOAP) and ebXML are among the topics to be discussed.

**Joint Meeting Objectives**

Wednesday afternoon, September 29, 2010, is reserved for a joint meeting of the AGIE/MAGIC Subcommittee and the NIS Subcommittee.

The purpose of this meeting is to determine how ARINC Standards being developed will enable airlines to implement end-to-end communications solutions using Internet Protocols (IP).

**NIS Meeting Objectives**

The Network Infrastructure and Security (NIS) Subcommittee, chaired by Jean-Paul Moreaux and Steve Arentz, will discuss the continued coordination efforts with DSWG and IETF, other topics related to aircraft networks, and continued development of **ARINC Project Paper 8xx: *Guidance for Usage of Digital Certificates.***

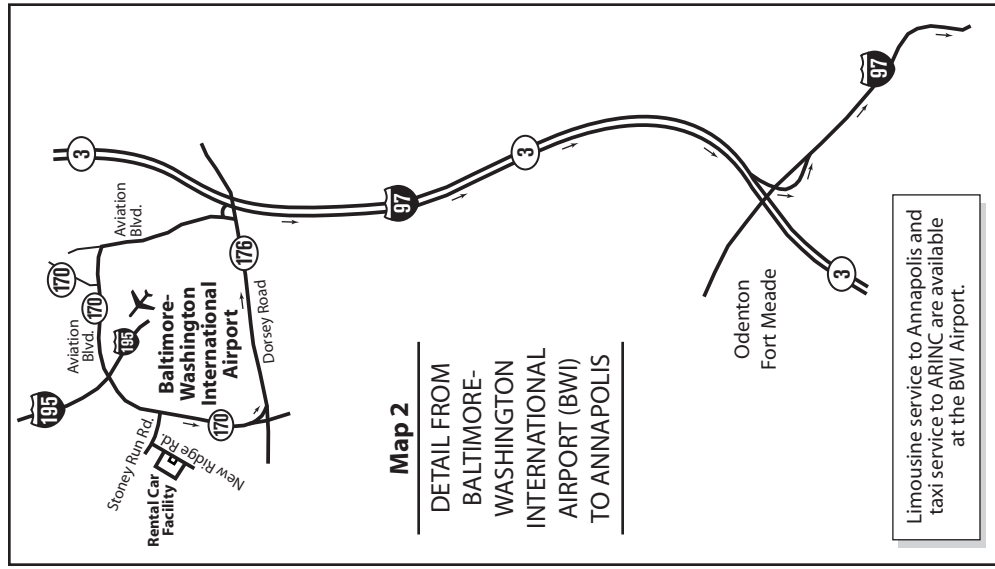
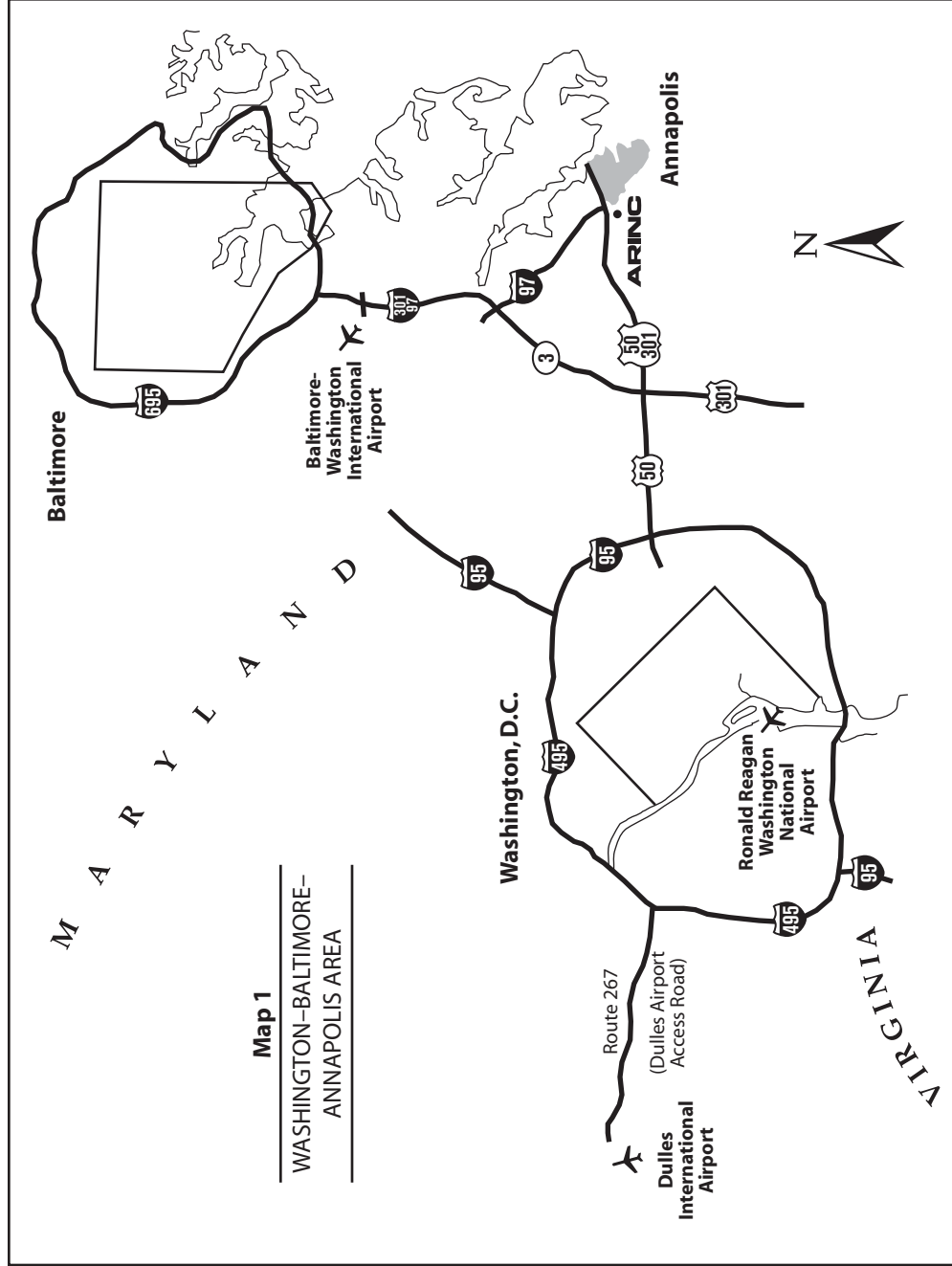
# DIRECTIONS TO ARINC'S HEADQUARTERS IN ANNAPOLIS, MARYLAND

**From Washington Dulles International Airport,** exit east on Washington Dulles Access Road (Route 267) to I-495. Take I-495 north/east; this becomes I-95. Exit east onto Route 50. (See Map 1.) Take exit 22 marked Aris T. Allen Boulevard (Route 665) and follow the signs to Riva Road. Turn right at the light onto Riva Road. The ARINC facilities are approximately 1/8 mile on the left on Admiral Cochrane Drive. (See Map 4.)

**From Baltimore-Washington International Airport,** exit the rental car facility on New Ridge Road to Stoney Run Road. Turn right on Stoney Run Road, and then make another right onto Aviation Boulevard (Route 170). At intersection with Dorsey Road (Route 176), exit left onto Dorsey Road. Follow Dorsey Road to exit for I-97 south (Annapolis and Bay Bridge). Turn right to take I-97/Route 3 south toward Annapolis. (See Map 2.) I-97 merges with Route 50. (See Map 4.) Immediately take exit 22 marked Aris T. Allen Boulevard (Route 665) and follow the signs to Riva Road. Turn right at the light onto Riva Road. The ARINC facilities are approximately 1/8 mile on the left on Admiral Cochrane Drive. (See Map 4.)

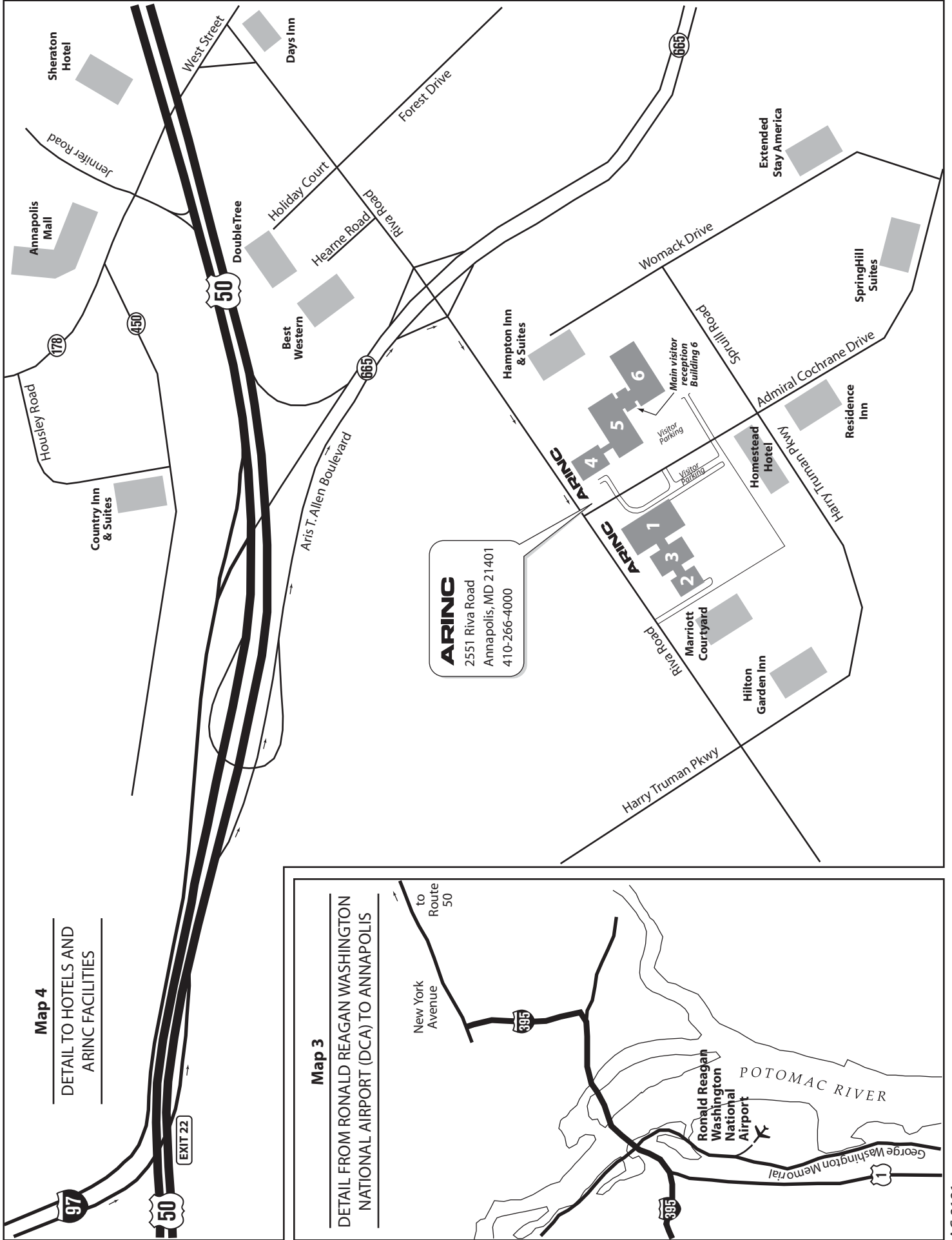
**From Washington,** take Route 50 east toward Annapolis. Take exit 22 marked Aris T. Allen Boulevard (Route 665). Turn right at the light onto Riva Road. The ARINC facilities are approximately 1/8 mile on the left on Admiral Cochrane Drive. (See Map 4.)

**From Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport,** exit north onto the George Washington Memorial Parkway and take I-395 north across the Potomac River. Stay on I-395 until it dead ends at New York Avenue. Turn right onto New York Avenue and follow the signs for Route 50 east to Annapolis. (See Map 3.) Take exit 22 marked Aris T. Allen Boulevard (Route 665) and follow the signs to Riva Road. Turn right at the light onto Riva Road. The ARINC facilities are approximately 1/8 mile on the left on Admiral Cochrane Drive. (See Map 4.)



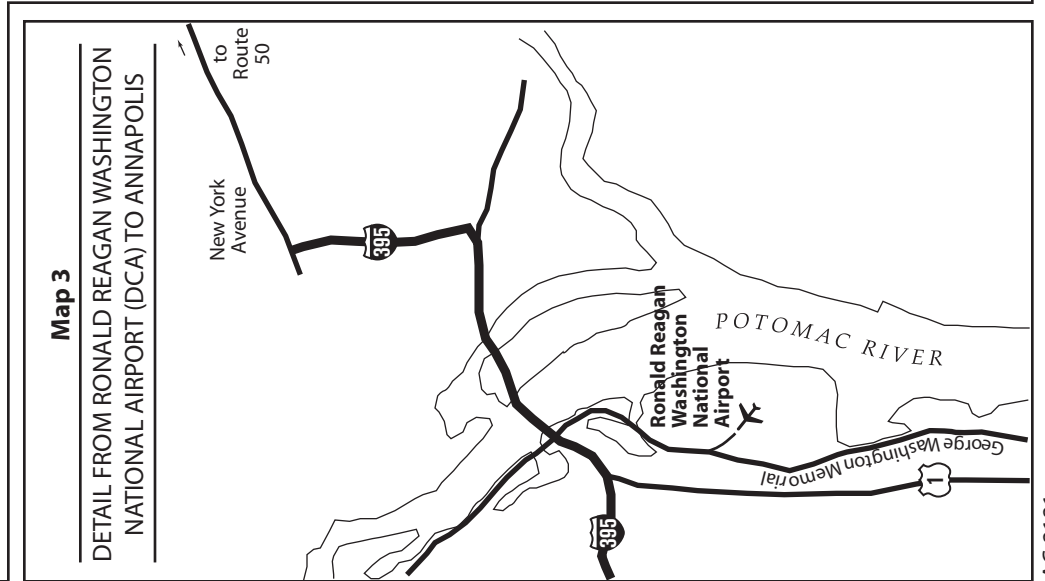

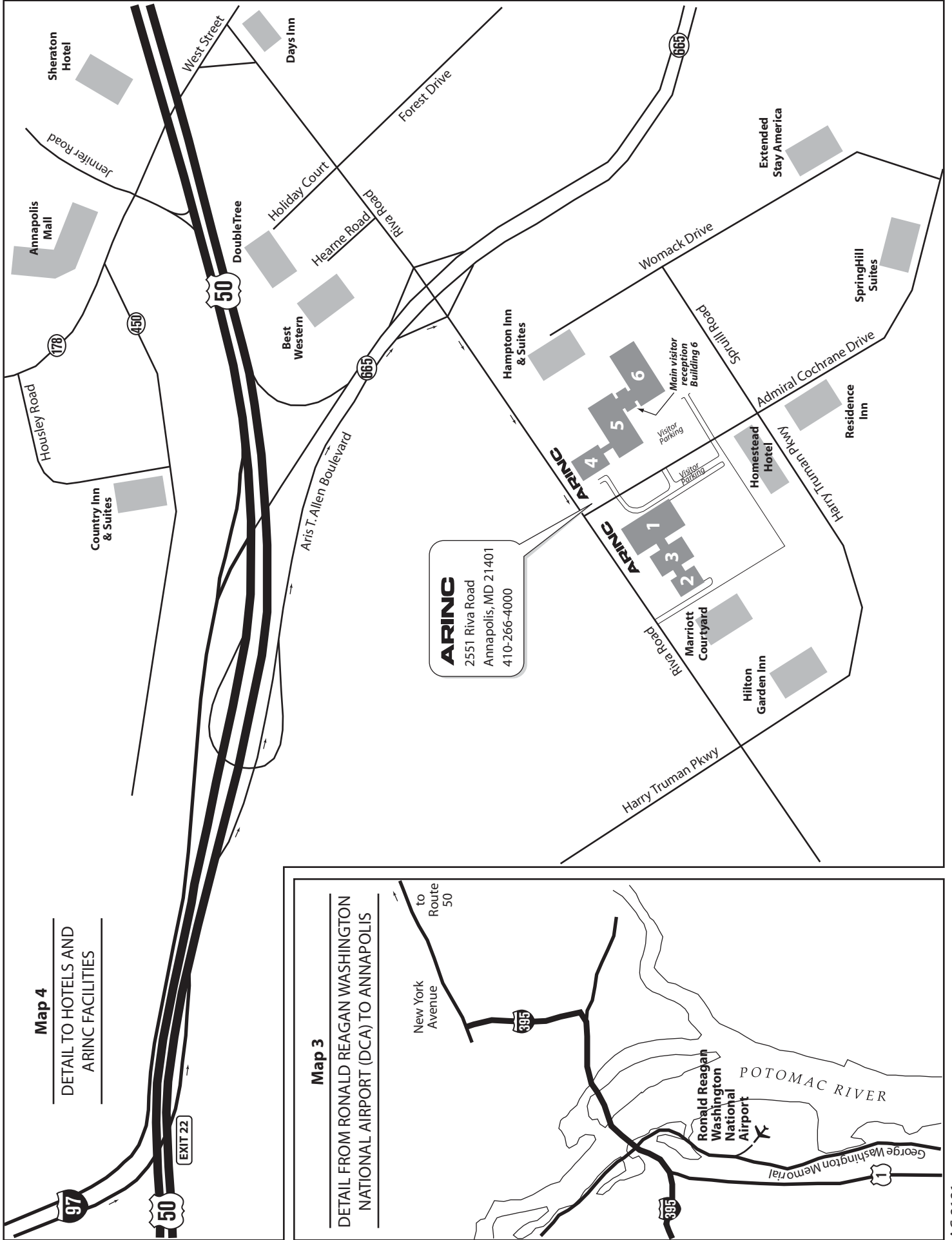
DETAIL FROM RONALD REAGAN WASHINGTON
